Welcome back to campus from what I hope was a terrific summer break! As you might know, there is a large renovation happening at the IU School of Public Health-Bloomington (SPH-B). **This will affect both how you get into the building and how you access the spaces inside.**

To get to the Student Services suite, you must enter through one of these doors on the east side of the building:

- Northeast entrance (closest to the arboretum and bell tower)
- East entrance (closer to the art museum)



All doors on the west side of the building—[including the main entrance](#)—are locked during renovation.

Once you get inside, there should be signs to help you find the Student Services suite which includes Academic Advising, Career Services, and International Programs.
