- ✓ Available to participate in 6-week in person research experience in Bloomington, Indiana from *May 28 to July 5, 2024*
- ✓ Self-identifying as being from a background underrepresented in science as defined by NIH

Submit the following materials by December 15.

- A 1-page resume with institution, year of study, and GPA.
- A 1-page personal statement that describes *a) Background; b) Achievements; c) Interests & career goals in lung disease research.*
- Combine all materials above in single PDF document.
